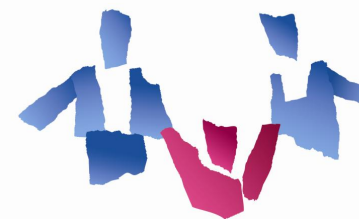

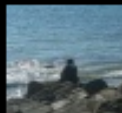

Domestic violence doesn't always start on the first date.
But there are warning signs that could signal a possible threat of abuse.

**GET ADVICE
NOW**

Is someone you like...

- Always jealous. Doesn't want you to see other friends?
- Humiliating you. Making you feel like you're not good enough?
- Wanting to know where you are all the time?
- Putting sexual pressure on you?
- Trying to control how you dress, what you do and say?
- Making you feel guilty for your actions?
- Threatening to harm you or self harm if you leave the relationship?

Do you threaten your partner?

- Abuse is when you hurt another person physically, emotionally, sexually or mentally.
- Do you recognise this in your relationship?

Are you worried your children are...

- Witnessing too many arguments between their parents?
- Seeing or listening to violence is very frightening for a child.
- "In 90% of cases of domestic violence, the children are in the same or next room." - (Hughes, 1992)
- "750,000 children a year witness domestic violence" - (Dept. of Health, 2002)

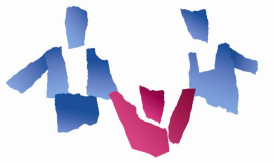
